Scope:

This specification is intended to cover the packaging requirements of parts for shipment to and from outside processing (e.g., heat-treating, plating or coating, etc.).

General Specifications:

- 1. All parts must be packaged in durable, reusable containers with adequate internal separation to ensure the delivery of the parts to and from the processor without damage.
- 2. SPC parts will normally be shipped in custom-built containers as pictured below

3. Some parts will be shipped in Euro crates as pictured below.



- 4. Layers of parts will be separated by corrugated cardboard or plywood.
- 5. Threaded parts should be protected with plastic mesh tubing.
- 6. Parts to be painted will be shipped with a sufficient quantity of paper or other wrapping material to be used to protect against damage to the finish on the return trip.
- 7. Lids will be screwed or strapped on as required to protect the loads.
- 8. All processed parts will be returned from suppliers packed as well or better (e.g. painted parts) than as received.
