Parts Listed Per Wheel or Per Axle

Q1: Some parts are listed per wheel and some per axle. What's the difference?

A1: A kit listed "per wheel" supplies enough parts to service one corner of the suspension, either right OR left of the front or rear suspension. A kit that is listed "per axle" supplies enough parts to service both the right and left sides of either the front or rear suspension.

For example, kit 25470 is listed "per axle" and therefore shipped with two front upper control arms. If you want to replace both upper control arms of your vehicle, you would purchase 1 kit.

Alternately, kit 66040 is listed "per wheel". This kit only supplies one control arm. If you want to replace both upper control arms, you would purchase 2 kits.

When purchasing a kit, the labor rate is also listed "per wheel" or "per axle", so always multiply the labor rate by the number of kits you purchase.
